The wind also caused us to lose heat in our overwintering house, knocking out the propane pilot, blowing breakers, and freezing out many plants.

Then you have the multitude of shipping and supply issues. Last year, our largest seed source closed its doors after 95 years of business. On top of that, you have general seed shortages, some of which caused by acres of seed fields destroyed by wildfires and increased demand. The U.S. Post Office...unreliable at their best. Don't get me started on UPS and FedEx not knowing what arrows on boxes mean. Fact. My cell phone contains pictures of 2 things- Arya and damaged goods.

Toss in some health issues for all of us here (all non-Covid related concerns), inflation of every product we use in the growing of plants, Arya starting first grade at school (which can only be described as chaotic), and of course, all the Covid craziness. I am extremely sad to say Covid claimed a family member, Charity's sister, Hope Meals, as well as some dear friends. Losses that will not easily heal. Yet no matter how tested we have been, we are thankful. Thankful for all the well wishes. Thankful for all of you, our faithful. Thankful for all the new people who have discovered the values of gardening. Thankful for our family and friends who help us to continue doing what we do.

In these times we have stepped up our sanitation to another level. We are willing to go the extra mile to keep us all safe. Please feel free to make suggestions. One thing that won't change is our goal to honor my dad and his dream by continuing to grow a large array of healthy bedding plants, annuals, perennials, vegetables- including 111 tomato varieties and 105 pepper varieties, and a large selection of herbs and scented geraniums. Our perennial collection containing many new and unusual varieties, 65 hosta cultivars and 51 different hemerocallis, fruit stock and herbs, will continue to be available throughout the summer. In fall we will have mums, pumpkins, gourds, and flowering cabbage and kale grown in our gardens. By December we will be ready with many varieties of poinsettias and greenery. Many mixed flower containers, herb gardens, hanging baskets, pouches and fiber baskets are available or could be made to order. We will constantly add new garden art, crafts, flags, tools, gloves, soils, seeds and garden supplies. My mom, Rexine, will still give many talks appropriate for garden clubs, churches, and social groups, now that we can once again congregate. We will also host greenhouse tours. Please do not hesitate to inquire. We will continue to take great pride in keeping an organized and clean greenhouse. Our meticulous love and care will still be seen in the quality of our plants.
